RULES – 2nd ANNUAL ORANGE BELT USBC CHAMPIONSHIPS

1. The Tournament shall be certified by the United States Bowling Congress and all applicable USBC rules will govern this tournament. Only members of the Orange Belt USBC are eligible to enter. Non-USBC members living within the jurisdiction of this Association (who are not members of another association) may enter by paying an affiliate membership fee of \$18.00.
2. **ENTRIES:** Entries close at midnight February 21, 2008. Entry fee will be \$16.00 per person per event. All Events (optional) is \$3.00. Scratch Singles event (optional) is \$10.00 per person. **ENTRIES SUBMITTED AFTER February 21, 2008 ARE SUBJECT TO A \$5 PER EVENT LATE FEE** but no entries are permitted after the first squad begins to bowl.
3. **MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:** A bowler may participate more than once only in the team event; no more than three (3) of the original bowlers can compete together on another 5 member team. No more than two (2) on another 4 member team. No multiple entries in single or doubles.
4. **ALL EVENTS (optional):** Bowlers entering the All Events must indicate so in the appropriate box on the entry form. Contestants may enter the All Events only once. A bowler's first appearance in the team event shall count towards the All Event score. An All Event entry over 60 years of age at the time of their first event will automatically be entered in the Senior All Events at no cost.
5. **AVERAGES:** Averages to be used in this tournament will be the bowler's highest USBC 2006-2007 yearbook average from any Association. A bowler who has no 2006-2007 Orange Belt yearbook average must use their highest Orange Belt league average of at least twenty-one (21) games as of January 1, 2008 or their yearbook average from another association whichever is higher. A bowler who does not have an acceptable regular season Orange Belt average or other Association yearbook average may use their summer Orange Belt league average of 21 games or more. A bowler using an established average from another Association must be currently bowling in a league in this Association. Rule 319a, Item 2 (10 Pin Rule) should be followed regarding entering averages. No YABA averages will be allowed. Bowlers with no established average will use 230 for handicap purposes.
6. **PBA MEMBERSHIP:** Team Captains are required to report to the Tournament Director any bowlers that presently hold a PBA card or have ever held a PBA card with this entry form.
7. **HANDICAPS:** Handicaps will be computed based on 90% of the difference between each bowler's average and 230 scratch.
8. **AWARDS & PRIZES:** ALL PRIZE MONEY WILL BE RETURNED 100%. The minimum cash prize shall not be less than the prize fee. All cash prizes will be awarded on a handicap basis. The Assn. Awards Committee will determine specific cash prizes after the number of entries is known. There will be NO ROLL-OFFS. In case of ties for any position, all prize money for the position in question will be combined and divided equally. No awards or prizes will be presented until the Association Manager has certified the winner's averages. A preliminary prize list will be posted prior to the commencement of the tournament. All awards will be awarded on both a handicap and scratch basis to the winners in each event. There will be one cash prize awarded for one in six (6) entries in each event except for Senior All Events which will be one in four (4). Awards for Scratch Team, Singles, Doubles and All Events will be awarded. In case of a tie for these awards, duplicate prizes will be awarded and the involved declared co-champions.
9. **ENTRY FORMS:** Entry forms must be completely filled out showing first and second choice of squads. No changes in bowling order for team or doubles will be permitted on day of bowling.
10. **SCHEDULES:** All team captains will be notified of their scheduled squad times. Lane assignments will be available at check-in. Entrants shall not practice on their assigned lanes within one hour of their scheduled bowling time.
11. **TEAM CAPTAINS:** Team captains must check in 30 minutes before the team's scheduled bowling time. No changes will be made in the lineup (from entry blank) unless substitutions are involved. Substitutions must be made at least 30 minutes before scheduled time to bowl. No blinds or pacers shall be permitted.
12. **OFFICIAL SCORE:** The telescore will be the Official Score and will be accepted as such. Signatures of Scorers, Team Captains and opposing Team Captains will be required on team recap sheets. Doubles and Singles recap sheets will require signature of scorer, one participant and an opponent. Errors in scoring must be reported within 24 hours after bowling to the Tournament Director.
13. **PROTESTS:** Any rule infractions, protests or disagreements shall be referred directly to the Rules Committee on duty. See USBC Rule #329 pertaining to protest.
14. The team captain has the responsibility for notifying all team members of their scheduled assignment and reporting all substitutions. Any prize money won will be mailed to the team captain for distribution to the team members approximately three weeks after the tournament.
15. **SCRATCH SINGLES EVENT:** Entries for the Scratch Optional Event will be allowed 15 minutes prior to squad starting time. You cannot just enter this scratch event only. Your 6 games scratch total in the regular singles and doubles will be used for your standing in the scratch event. Total event fee will be returned as prize dollars.
