The FLORIDA WOMEN'S CLASSIC is a USBC certified singles, scratch, match play tournament.

1. BOWLING EQUIPMENT:

Each entrant will be allowed a maximum of two bowling balls on the ball return at one time.

Powder: No substance, including talcum powder or EZ slide, can be applied to the player's shoes once the bowler has begun competition.

Rosin: Once the competition begins, the outer surface of the ball may not be altered in any way. The only exception – a dry towel may be used.

2. CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY:

A refund will be given, less \$25.00 cancellation fee, if written notice is received by September 10, 2011. No refund will be given if written notice is received after September 10, 2011 or later. Those who withdraw/cancel may obtain their own replacements. Bowlers who obtain replacements will make their own arrangements as to repayment of their individual entry fees. The Florida USBC WBA must be notified of replacements no later than 1 hour prior to the start of competition.

3. DATES & LOCATION:

September 17, 2011 at Pin Street at Fort Myers located at 4140 Fowler St., Fort Myers, Fl. First round will begin at 1:00 P.M.

4. DELAYS:

If a delay of 10 minutes or longer occurs during competition, tournament management, at their discretion, may authorize warm up ball(s) on another lane(s) not being used for competition.

5. DRESS CODE:

Entrants are expected to wear suitable attire. Use good judgment when selecting the appropriate attire. Examples of prohibited attire include but are not limited to: Tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops and short shorts. Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament management or designee. Tournament management or designee's decision will be final.

6. EATING – DRINKING – SMOKING:

Entrants are NOT permitted to smoke or drink alcoholic beverages while participating in the Florida Women's Classic. This includes from the start of practice to the last ball thrown for score in qualifying, match play and finals. A small snack will be permitted. No gambling of any form (including cards) will be permitted.

7. ELIGIBILITY:

All participants must be women and have a current USBC WBA adult membership. If current membership cannot be verified, USBC membership card must be purchased at the tournament site at a cost of \$21.00. All non-merged association participants need to be members of their local WBA association. If not, they will be permitted to pay local dues (\$10.00) and state dues (\$1.00) at the tournament. Merged association participants that have not paid FL state dues (\$1.00) may do so at the tournament.

8. ETIQUETTE:

Unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated on the lanes or inside the tournament venue. Individuals are subject to ejection for engaging in improper tactics or conduct including, but not limited to, physical and verbal abuse toward another person.

9. FEES:

\$80.00 per participant

Prize fee will be paid out 100%.

Prize ratio will be 1 in 5

10. FORMAT:

The Florida Women's Classic is a singles, scratch, match play format tournament. One qualifying round of five games will be held to determine the qualifying positions of the top half of field (with uneven number of participants being rounded up) for the second round with all pins carried forward. A 3 game match play of the high qualifiers will be matched highest against lowest qualifier, etc. The winner of each match will be given 25 bonus pins, which will be added prior to re-matching. This will determine the highest five qualifiers for a stepladder roll off. No pins will be carried into the step-ladder roll off. A player arriving late will begin play and her score will count beginning with the frame then being bowled. If there is a tie for the final position needed to complete the top half of field, a complete 9th and 10th frame shall immediately be bowled. The tied bowlers will draw for the starting lane, and the bowler on the odd lane will start. Bowlers shall be allowed two practice deliveries on each of the starting lanes. The procedure continues until a tie is broken. In the event of a tie for any other position, the bowler with the highest three game qualifying series will be placed in the higher position. Should a tie still exist, the high single qualifying game will be used. If necessary, the second high qualifying game will be used, and so on down until the tie is broken.

STEPLADDER FINALS:

The stepladder finals will be a single-elimination format. Positions are determined as follows:

One-game match against position #5 vs. #4, Winner vs. #3, Winner vs. #2, Winner vs. #1. Top score of the last two bowlers will determine the over-all champion. Top 5 positions will cash. Should a tie occur in the stepladder roll-off games, a complete 9th and 10th frame shall be bowled until there is a clear winner. The winner of the 9th and 10th frame will advance to the next match.

11. LANE OIL PATTERN: Lane oil pattern will be Sport Bowling compliant and open knowledge to participants.

12. REGISTRATION/CHECK IN:

All bowlers must check in at least 30 minutes prior to qualifying and match play. Current USBC membership must be shown.

13. START OF COMPETITION – Definition

Start of competition begins with the participant's first ball thrown for score during qualifying, match play and finals.

14. OTHER RULES:

Tournament management has the final authority to make decisions regarding anything not covered in these rules.
